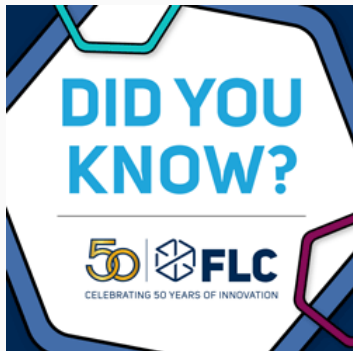

1991: The American Technology Preeminence Act

The American Technology Preeminence Act of 1991 contained several provisions covering the FLC and the use of CRADAs. 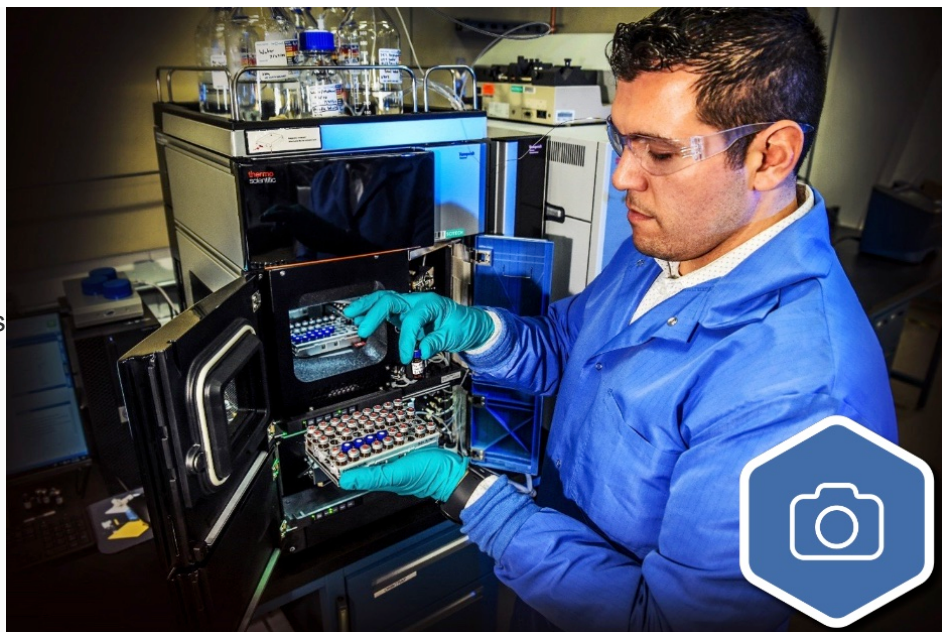
