USDA ARS-Led Team's Gene Editing-Tech Produces First Calf Resistant to Major Virus

Scientists from the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Agricultural Research Service and partners from academia and industry have collaborated to produce the first gene-edited calf with resistance to bovine viral diarrhea virus, which costs the U.S. cattle sector billions of dollars annually. A vaccine has been available for 50 years but is not always effective in preventing transmission.

Water-Focused Team Including TWC Wins \$1M NSF Engines Development Award

The Water Council, an FLC Partner, is part of a team that has been awarded a two year, \$1 million grant from the National Science Foundation to plan a Regional Innovation Engine in eastern Wisconsin addressing water and energy resilience for manufacturers and utilities. At the end of the two years, the Engine team will apply for a Launch Award of up to \$160 million over 10 years.
